Lawn bowls is one of Australia's most popular sports. In more than 2000 lawn bowling clubs around the country, an estimated 370,000 men and women are actively involved in the game. One of the reasons for the growing popularity of lawn bowls is that people of most ages and level of physical ability can play the game.

Australians with physical impairments soon discover that lawn bowls is a sport where they can not only participate, but quickly reach a standard that is comparable to and competitive with many able-bodied bowlers.

Disabled bowlers can compete at all levels, including championship and pennants, as there are no rule differences for wheelchair Lawn bowls.

While the bowling community is welcoming of wheelchair bowlers, greenkeepers have been known to become very nervous indeed, as wheelchairs have the potential to dent and damage the playing surface.

Problems:

- Rear wheels, even with wider back tyres, can damage the green.
- Heavy tread can dent the green.
- Front wheels dig in and damage the playing surface, especially in wet weather.
- Small front wheels can gouge deep ruts in the green if turning a tight circle.
- Conventional backswing must be modified to avoid contact with the large rear wheels of the chair.

Solution: Green Wheeler!

The Green Wheeler is a totally new concept in bowling wheelchairs. Developed with the assistance of green keepers, people with disabilities and bowlers of all ages, the Green Wheeler is the product of ETS Australia, a business initiative of the Cerebral Palsy League of Queensland. ETS has now succeeded in bringing to life a bowling wheelchair that is uniquely suited to both the needs of the wheelchair bowler and a top class playing surface.

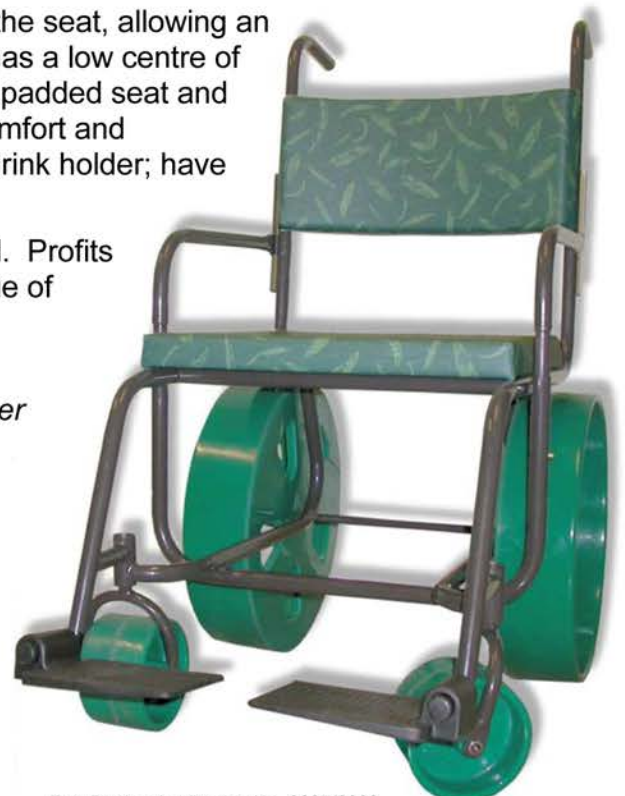
The Green Wheeler features unique wide front and rear wheels moulded from advanced materials that simply glide over the bowling surface. In recent field trials, The Green Wheeler has been demonstrated to have minimal impact on a greens playing surface. Even on a wet green with a 95kg user, the Green Wheeler left no impressions.

The rear wheels of the Green Wheeler are recessed under the seat, allowing an unobstructed and natural bowling action. The frame itself has a low centre of gravity to ensure optimal stability and safety for the user. A padded seat and backrest as well as height-adjustable armrests offer both comfort and postural support, while a range of accessories, including a drink holder; have been carefully planned with the bowler's need in mind.

The Green Wheeler is totally Australian-made and designed. Profits from sales support the services of the Cerebral Palsy League of Queensland.
