RE: Club Life Membership & Suspension and Expulsion **Ref:** 16/024

The following information as requested by District and Club secretaries.

Club Life Members

The matter was raised regarding club life members who were no longer bowlers, or those who were infirm or had moved out of the area.

These club life members, should you wish to do so, can be removed from the BQ register by recording them on a Form 2 as resigned. However, a copy of the letter of resignation from the member or a letter from the club explaining the reason they are being recorded as resigned must accompany the appropriate Form 2. They will not be processed without this information. When these members have been recorded as resigned they will no longer be eligible to play bowls and they will not be able to receive any meritorious or life membership awards from Bowls Queensland.

Please do not remove these club life members if they play bowls.

This requirement to enclose the letter with the Form 2 only applies to club life members and not general resignations.

Suspensions and Expulsions

Bowls Queensland Constitution suspensions and expulsions.

A Club may suspend or expel a member from their club only.
When an interclub clearance is issued it must state that the member is suspended or expelled.

A District may suspend or expel a member from clubs in their district only.

A member who is suspended or expelled by Bowls Queensland will not be eligible to play bowls at any club which is affiliated with Bowls Queensland.

Notification of suspension or expulsion must still be advised to BQ and we will advise district secretaries accordingly who will advise clubs. When a member is reinstated this must be notified to Bowls Queensland on a Form 2.
