Bowls Queensland would now like to resume accreditation and reaccreditation for all Coaches and Officials; however taking into consideration the number allowed to attend sessions and following COVID plans. For the protection of trainers and members attending courses, BQ have reduced the maximum number of attendees to 6 for each course.
