**Re:** Expressions of Interest to host the 2021 State Champion of Club Champions

Expressions of interest are now being called to host the 2021 State Champion of Club Champions.

The State Champion of Club Champions will be held from October 23 to 28, 2021.

Sunday: 8.15am - Trial Ends; 8.30am – Round 3; Lunch; 12.45pm – Finals

**Mon 25 & Tue 26 Oct** **Men's & Women's Pairs (8 men's teams & 8 women's teams)**  
Monday: 8.00am –Welcome to include group winner presentation;  
8.15am – Trial Ends; 8.30am – Round 1; Lunch; 1.00pm - Round 2  
Tuesday: 8.15am – Trial Ends; 8.30am – Round 3; Lunch; 12.45pm – Finals

**Wed 27 & Thur 28 Oct** **Men's & Women's Singles (8 men & 8 women) \*\* Markers are required**  
Wednesday: 8.00am –Welcome to include group winner presentation;  
8.15am – Trial Ends; Three Rounds to be played – Round 1 at 8.30am  
Thursday: 8.45am – Trial Ends; 9.00am - Finals

Greens required: A club is required to have two greens or one green with 8 rinks available each day for each discipline during sectional rounds. One green is required for the Finals of each discipline.

Green fees for the State Champion of Club Champions is \$20 per person per discipline and will be collected by Bowls Queensland and forwarded to the host club at the conclusion of the Championships.

Bowls QLD retains the right to engage sponsors, event supporters, event partners and commercial agreements relating to the Champion of Club Champions. This includes negotiations with the local Council. Clubs must not approach Council or Visitor Information centres for support. Unless in conjunction with Bowls QLD.

Clubs may partner with local businesses to offset the hosting costs, however any partner must not conflict with any Bowls QLD sponsors and approval must be obtained from Bowls QLD.

Clubs interested in hosting this event must have two greens available for the six days. Please complete the attached form and returned to Bowls Queensland by close of business on **Monday 8 February 2021**.
