The BA logo may appear in its traditional green and gold colouring, in a single colour "tone on tone" where the BA logo is the same colour as the base of the attire or in a single "colour matched" version where the logo is the same colour as a contrasting tone in the attire.

PROCEDURE

- Clubs must seek approval for “Club Colours & Shirt Design” by submitting an application for approval on the approved form to their District Association.
- The District Association shall be responsible for resolving any possible conflict within its own jurisdiction.
- The District Association must submit approved applications to the State Authority for formal registration.
- The State Authority shall maintain a master register of “Club Colours”
- Districts will be advised by the State Authority once the “Club Colours & Shirt Designs” are registered.

ATTIRE

Clubs may have any colour, design or style provided it is first approved by its District and then registered with Bowls Queensland.

For example, it is permissible to have a full coloured shirt and logos.

No club can have a design that conflicts with Bowls Queensland or the club’s District colour and design.

Within each club it is permissible to wear the club’s colours.
