Question 4 - Answer

The bowl is not a toucher in the current end and should be removed from the ditch. Should a player fail to remove a toucher mark from a bowl before playing it and should the bowl not become a toucher in the end in play, the mark

shall be removed by an opposing player or marker immediately the bowl comes to rest.

Law 15.5

A bowl is dead if, not being a toucher, it comes to rest in the ditch.
