Conditions of Play

The championship will be conducted under the current Crystal Mark Edition: Laws of the Sport of Bowls.

- 1. Format of the game will be three bowl pairs (each player plays three bowls).
- 2. Game duration: 9 ends per match or 1 hour time limit, roll up prior to first game each day only.
- 3. There will be no dead ends during the match. The Jack to be re-spotted on the T if the end is dead. (A dead end occurs when the Jack passes outside the rink boundary markers, over the bank or rebounds back on the green and is less than 18m from the front of the mat).
- 4. Each team gets to have one power-play per match. A power-play is where the score is doubled for that end. This is to be nominated before the first bowl for that end.
- 5. The winner of the previous end will deliver the jack anywhere on the centre line at a minimum distance of 21m from the front of the mat.
- 6. Closest bowl scores one shot and additional closest bowls from the same team score additional shots. The team at the end of the match with the greatest number of shots will be declared the winner. If scores are level, the match will be a tie.
- 7. Players in a team may consult their team teacher/coach/manager if required during the game; however the team teacher/coach/manager cannot interrupt the game to offer advice unless requested by the players.
- 8. The state winner will be the team with the highest total match points. If two or more teams are equal on total match points after round 9 of play the team with the highest margin will be the winner. (if still equal, the team with the highest percentage will be the winner) (total shots for minus shots against). Scoring for the competition will be: Win = 2 Points, Tie = 1 Point, Loss = 0 Points
- 9. The controlling body has the right to alter the conditions to obtain a successful result.

Attire:

 Players shall wear school sports uniform or a team representative uniform with flat sole shoes.

Teams are encouraged to bring and display their school flags/banners as required


