

This strategic plan provides the blueprint for how Bowls Queensland will collaborate with our member clubs and other key partners to achieve our vision and purpose between 2023 and 2025.

Our vision: For all Queenslanders to connect with bowls during their lifetime.

Our purpose: To lead, encourage and support the Queensland bowls community to DO BOWLS DIFFERENTLY TO CONNECT MORE PEOPLE TO BOWLS – IN MORE WAYS – MORE OFTEN!

Our positioning: Strong clubs = strong future! We recognise that strong clubs are the key to the positive future of bowls in Queensland.

Our values: Our shared values define our character and guide how we behave when it matters most, as we work together to do what is best for the future of bowls in Queensland.

Care – We passionately care about the future of bowls and our member clubs.

Accountability - We do what we say we will do, when we say we will do it.

Respect – We value all stakeholders within the bowls community & what they can bring to the future of our sport. **Excellence** – We embrace change, have a growth mindset and strive to be better tomorrow than we are today.

WHAT IS REFRAMING THE FUTURE?

The overarching purpose of Bowls Queensland is: To lead, encourage and support the Queensland bowls community to DO BOWLS DIFFERENTLY TO CONNECT MORE PEOPLE TO BOWLS – IN MORE WAYS – MORE OFTEN!

REFRAMING THE FUTURE! has been developed to:

- ➔ Ensure Bowls Queensland is focusing on what is most important to our current and future sustainability and success;
- → Support the future capability and sustainability of our member clubs;
- → Build trust amongst all elements of the bowls community, through purposeful collaboration, for the benefit of clubs, Bowls Queensland and the sport; and
- → Maximise the relevance, visibility, and impact of bowls within the Queensland sport and recreation sector; and the broader community.
- → Support the delivery of the Queensland government's 10 year strategy designed to get more Queenslanders moving, more often (Activate! Queensland).

What Does Success Look Like? – A Snapshot

- Levels of trust and cooperation between Bowls Queensland, district associations and clubs is at an all-time high.
- More people are connecting with clubs and with bowls in more ways, more often – i.e. as social participants, competitive players, coaches, officials, volunteers, viewers, and partners.
- More bowls clubs are operating sustainable business models.
- More clubs are delivering social and modified game / competition formats to more people.
- New and improved Bowls Queensland events are connecting more people with clubs, Bowls Queensland and the sport.
- Bowls Queensland's reliance on affiliation as a revenue stream decreases.

The rapidly changing nature of the sport and active recreation landscape means the sustained success of bowls and its delivery system in Queensland is far from assured.

Bowls Queensland holds the view that we and our member clubs cannot stand still, nor can we continue to operate as we have done in the past, into the future. Change is a must, not a maybe!

Despite the challenges we face, we are taking an "opportunity focused approach" to how we plan for the future of bowls in Queensland.

As we deliver this strategic plan: We will do what is best for the future of bowls in Queensland, not what is easy!

Our Aligned Planning Framework

We are committed to fulfilling our roles and responsibilities within the Australian bowls landscape to the very best of our ability, whilst ensuring we prioritise the needs of member district associations, affiliated clubs, and bowls in Queensland, first and foremost.

In delivering our Strategic Plan, Bowls Queensland will engage with Bowls Australia and other State and Territory Associations (STAs) with the aim being to minimise duplication and maximise the benefits to bowls in our State.

Bowls Queensland, our member district associations and affiliated clubs, along with other key partners will work together and each play our part in bringing this plan to life. Working in isolation is not the answer – purposeful collaboration is!

- ➔ Bowls Queensland encouraging and supporting more clubs to undertake facility enhancement projects to improve the quality, appeal and viability of bowls club facilities across the State.
- ➔ Bowls Queensland working proactively with more clubs, local government authorities, developers and others, to maintain a network of club facilities, capable of growing bowls participation in Queensland.

STRATEGIC PROJECTS / ACTIONS

- Develop and implement a comprehensive *Club Development Plan,* designed to guide Bowls Queensland club support investment and activities, to help future proof bowls.
- Develop and implement a Bowls Queensland
 Statewide Facilities Plan to provide an evidence-based roadmap for the optimal mix of facilities for the future of bowls in Queensland.

SUCCESS INDICATORS

- ➔ Bowls Queensland's governance structures and systems align with current best practice.
- → Increased and diversified revenue streams are sourced to ease Bowls Queensland's reliance on affiliation fees by 2025.
- A high quality risk management framework is
 in place to safeguard Bowls Queensland and the sport.
- The Bowls Queensland staff and committee structure directly aligns with the effective and
 efficient activation of this strategic plan (strategy – structure – people).

STRATEGIC PROJECTS / ACTIONS

- Assess Bowls Queensland governance structures and systems against current best practice standards for State sporting organisations and make all necessary improvements.
- Achieve gender equity on the Bowls Queensland board by 2029.
- Maintain a Bowls Queensland Risk Management Framework and Risk Register.
- Undertake a review of the Bowls Queensland human resource structure (staff, committees and working parties, etc.) and implement recommendations.

OUR COMMITMENT TO THIS STRATEGIC PLAN

Our *REFRAMING THE FUTURE!* strategic plan will be delivered by living our values and working together as one bowls community.

Bowls Queensland's operations between 2023 and 2025 will be guided by this document – used by staff, monitored by the board and formally reviewed annually. Importantly, Bowls Queensland will develop annual operational plans, which incorporate financial allocations for each strategic project being implemented during the relevant 12-month period. In addition to our business-as-usual activities, we will successfully complete our strategic projects in a timely manner, to the highest possible standard, and ensure the financial management of Bowls Queensland remains sound at all times.

We will use a range of internal and external measurements to monitor our progress against the success indicators within this plan. In particular, we will monitor the number, and diversity of people engaging in all forms of bowls – focusing on how, when, where, how often and why they participate and/or connect with bowls and clubs.

We will concentrate on our commercial success, ensuring the ongoing financial sustainability of Bowls Queensland, which will allow us to put more back into the sport.

The sustained success of Queensland State teams, increased club membership, increased participation in new and innovative participation products and events, and greater connection with our clubs and districts, will all help us achieve our strategic objectives, and in doing so, to achieve our purpose:
